Revision Checklist for ADVANCED LEARNERS

Learners may generate more extensive checklists and include more open-ended questions for peer review. For example:

___ What does the writer want to say?

___ Is it said clearly?

___ Are the sentences in the best order?

___ Are the paragraphs well developed?

___ Is there effective support for the ideas?

___ Do the ideas flow logically?

___ Is it clear how all of the details relate to the main idea?

- Do you need to add (+) ideas to make this clear?
- Do you need to take out (-) ideas to make this clear?
